Sam opened the door.

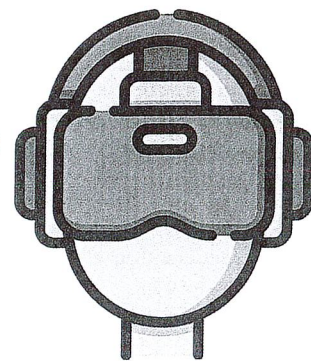
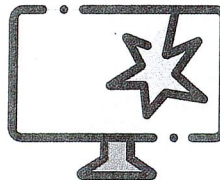
"We're fine," he shouted back, "Dwayne just fell over."
