



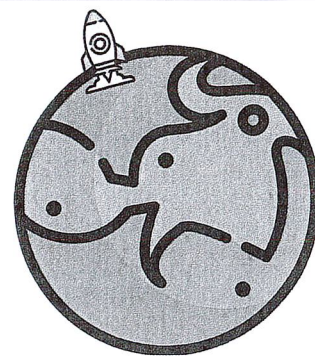
QUICK COMPS - RED LANDING
